EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR RECOVERY

Gateway Homes, Inc. is pleased to announce its partnership with Health Planning Region II to provide intensive community-based residential services in Annandale, Virginia. This licensed residential program services eight adults with serious mental illness and focuses on promoting hope, recovery, self-determination, and the highest level of independence possible. Individuals are referred for admission by the Regional Utilization Group's Aftercare Manager's Committee. This regional collaboration is managed by the Northern Virginia Regional Projects Office and the Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board. 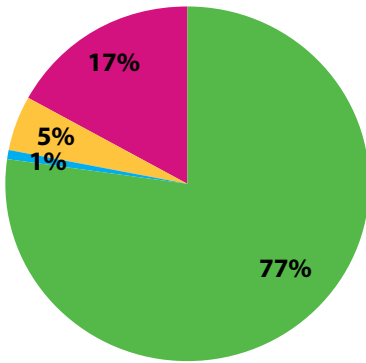

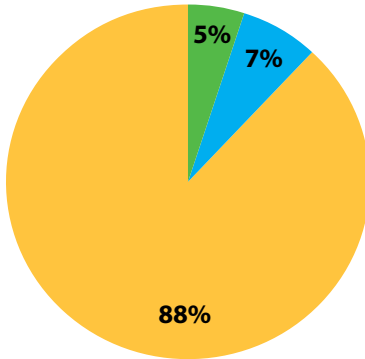
2011 Revenue

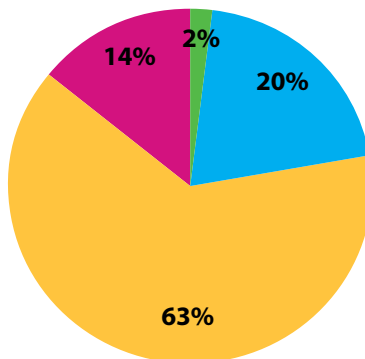
